





Costa Rica is a tropical country with several climatic zones and a great diversity of microclimates, each with its own characteristics. The country's annual average temperature ranges from 22° C (71° F) to 27° C (81° F). The sun shines all year round, about 12 hours a day, and there are only two seasons: the dry season (with less rain) from December to May, and the rainy season (with abundant greenery) from May to November.

The broad range of tourist attractions and rich biological diversity distributed throughout the territory benefit from a pleasant climate that allows visitors to enjoy many activities year-round. Even though it occupies only 0.03% of the world's land surface, Costa Rica is home to almost 4% of the world's species, making it one of the top 20 countries with the highest biodiversity in the world.

include 33 national parks, 8 biological reserves, 61 wildlife refuges, 14 wetlands and some private reserves.

Cocos Island National Park, the Guanacaste Conservation Area and the La Amistad Reserve in the Talamanca mountain range have been declared WORLD HERITAGE SITES by UNESCO.

Costa Rica is home to more than 10,000 species of plants and trees, 850 species of resident, migratory, endemic and endangered birds, 205 mammal species, more than 35,000 insect species, 160 amphibian species, more than 220 species of reptiles, and over 1000 species of freshwater and salt

1 EXCELLENT AIR CONNECTIONS

Excellent air connections and frequent flights from Europe and the American continent have helped make Costa Rica a convenient hub in the Central American region.

Currently, 24 airlines serve Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO), with regular non-stop flights to more than 36 destinations around the world. In addition, Daniel Oduber Quirós International Airport (LIR) in Guanacaste is serviced by 12 airlines with regular flights to 17 destinations.

Juan Santamaría Airport is the second best on the Central American isthmus, according to the Skytrax ranking (World Airport Awards 2015), in aspects of quality and general passenger experience.

In early 2017, The Official Airline Guide of London and FlightStats unveiled their punctuality rankings for the world, with outstanding companies operating in Costa Rica, such as COPA Airlines, Alaska Airlines and Iberia.

(2) HIGH TECHNOLOGY

Costa Rica has become a center of operations for large multinational companies, largely because it has a very high quality technological platform and highly qualified professionals. For this reason, United States and European companies demand software manufactured in the country; moreover, Costa Rica is a leader in the production of medical technology in Latin America.

We also have an excellent telecommunications network with very affordable rates for Internet services and free access to online information, which is why Costa Rica is the best-connected country in Central America according to the World Economic Forum's 2015 Global Report on Information Technology.

In addition, the country has a robust electricity grid supplied by renewable energies including geothermal, wind and hydroelectric.

In 2017, the country ranked 49th on the list of 143 economies with respect to the adoption of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT), achieving the highest rate of internet access (58% of the population) in Latin America.

Growth in the use of social networks has been reported for most socioeconomic levels in Costa Rica. These digital platforms are becoming an important part of day-to-day transactions, commerce and communication in Costa Rica.



Costa Rica exports: medical devices, electronic components, software development, fruit juices and concentrates, coffee, bananas, pineapple, cantaloupe, watermelon and other fruits and vegetables.



According to the World Banks' Human Opportunity Index (HOI), Costa Rica has the highest rate of Internet Access in the Latin American region, corresponding to 58% of the population.




The 2016 Global Innovation Index puts Costa Rica in second place in Latin America and the Caribbean.

3 HIGH QUALITY HEALTH SERVICES

The Costa Rican healthcare system is financed through the Social Security system and the general taxes collected by the State, and it is inspired by the principles of universality, equality and equity, which have produced highly successful health indexes. As of December 2015, Costa Rica had 29 hospitals consisting of 3 national hospitals, 7 regional hospitals, 6 specialized hospitals and 13 peripheral hospitals.

According to the 2014 International Living Index, Costa Rica ranks fourth in the world for best quality health services. The study noted, "It has the highest quality, affordable healthcare and is known as one of the most peaceful countries in Latin America (having enjoyed more than 60 years of uninterrupted democratic government)."









In the Human Development Index (HDI) prepared by the United Nations to measure the progress of a country and show the standard of living of its inhabitants, Costa Ricans rank 69th.

4 EDUCATION IN COSTA RICA

The Global Education Rankings of the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) put Costa Rica in 53rd place.

In Costa Rica, education is governed by the Ministry of Education and by law primary to secondary education have been free,

compulsory, and State-funded since 1869

Costa Rica is one of the happiest countries in the world according to the Happy Planet Index, and many visitors find that it really is a beautiful place to live, explore and enjoy life!



The literacy rate in Costa Rica is 97.4% according to the United Nations 2015 Human Development Report, making it one of the most literate countries in Latin America.





(5) CULTURE AND HIGH CUISINE

Costa Ricans ('Ticos") are known as a very pleasant, happy people, living the pure life (pura vida). Pura Vida is a cordial greeting, a popular expression that denotes a person's state of happiness and joy; it reflects a hope that everything can be better and finally, it is a personal philosophy, a lifestyle.

Costa Rican cuisine is part of the nation's identity and it is the product of three main cultural influences: Aboriginal, Spanish and African. With the construction of the railroad to the Atlantic region and the consolidation of the banana enclave on the Caribbean coast, immigrants from Jamaica, China, Italy, Spain and Germany arrived, contributing recipes, ingredients and different styles, and bringing new flavors to Costa Rican cuisine. Fusion cuisine and craft beer production are now well developed.



Thanks to its geographical position, climate, rugged terrain and the influence of its two coasts, Costa Rica produces a wide variety of fresh fruits, vegetables, tubers, seafood and meats that enrich its gastronomic culture.

Costa Rica is recognized for the creative talents of its renowned artists, including the painters Francisco Amighetti, Rafa Fernández and more recently Adrián Gómez, as well as the sculptor Jorge Jiménez Deredia, distinguished as one of the most prominent sculptors in Latin America due to his success in Italy and the Vatican.



A group of pre-Columbian settlements with more than 500 Diquis stone spheres was designated a World Heritage Site in 2014 by UNESCO.

The National Symphony Orchestra gives musical performances that include Costa Rican and classical music, among others; its schedule for 2017 includes more than 70 concerts, half of which are free.







COMMITMENT TO THE ENVIRONMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY

Costa Rica made the decision to conserve and protect the environment almost 70 years ago, and it was also one of the first countries to assume the serious commitment of reforesting lands that had been logged. At present, it is a recognized world leader in the use of clean, renewable energy. In 2016, 98% of the electricity produced came from environmentally friendly sources: water, geothermal, wind, biomass and solar. In 2017, four new wind plants will be inaugurated and better hydro-meteorological conditions are expected to reduce if not eliminate dependence on fossil fuels.

In Costa Rica, more than 60

Carbon-Neutral seal, according to the latest State of the Nation Report.

The State encourages sustainable tourism and as a result, more than 300 companies have obtained the Sustainable Tourism Certificate (hotels, tour operators, restaurants, theme parks, car rental companies). This certification is voluntary and rates companies according to their environmental and social responsibility practices, engagement with the communities where their operations are located, and specific actions that favor nature conservation.
